Upcoming Convention Deadlines

March 15:

April 15:

- Individual paper proposals for a Permanent Section or Pre-Organized Panel are due (no later than this date) to the organizer. For section- and panel-specific deadlines, please visit the <u>Permanent Section</u> and <u>Pre-Organized Panel</u> Calls for Papers. May 1: - All proposals for a <u>Pre-Organized Panel</u>, <u>Workshop</u>, and <u>Individual Paper for the Convention</u> or <u>the</u> <u>Undergraduate Research Symposium</u> are to be submitted to the MMLA using these linked forms. The Program Committee's decisions will be emailed to all candidates by the end of June.
