## 1. Applications for a Travel Award are Due July 1st

■ For the 2025 Convention, the MMLA will offer a limited number of travel awards to <u>part-time</u> faculty, <u>non-tenure track faculty</u>, <u>independent scholars</u>, and <u>graduate students</u> who have been selected to present a paper and need assistance paying for costs that are associated with traveling to and staying in Milwaukee, WI. ## 2. Nominations for the Annual Book Award are Due July 1st

During our November meeting, members of the MMLA's Executive Committee will award a \$500 prize to the <u>best scholarly book</u> published by an MMLA member between July 01, 2023 and June 30, 2025. Current MMLA members who wish to be considered for a Book Award must submit the requisite materials to the MMLA (<u>mmla@luc.edu</u>) by Tuesday, July 01. #### 3. Membership for the 2025-26 Fiscal Year Begins July 1st

Not So Fast! Wait until after July 01 to become a new member of, or to renew your membership with, the MMLA! MMLA memberships follow a fiscal-year calendar, meaning they run from July 1st of one year through June 30th of the next year. If you join now, your membership will expire in less than two weeks. If you wait until after July 1st, your membership will last twelve months, including the upcoming 2025 convention in November. Sometimes procrastination is the right choice! ## 4. Convention Registration Opens July 1st

Registration fees cover costs associated with running the meeting, such as A/V equipment, technicians, Wi-Fi, coffee service, and food for the President's Reception, among others.
